



He messaged you that he's HIV undetectable?

Being HIV undetectable is when a person living with HIV has such a low amount of the virus in their body that it can't be detected by a blood test.

Antiretroviral treatments taken regularly considerably reduce the number of copies of HIV, also called "viral load", in the body. The lower the viral load, the lower the risk of transmission.
